


Children and Young People's Occupational Therapy and Physiotherapy referral pathway



The child/young person will have an initial appointment with one or more of the professionals getting involved

This may be in a clinic, hospital, school/nursery or at the child/young person's home. Following this, if necessary, further assessments may be needed and will be arranged.

Once all planned assessments have taken place

- The parent/carer, child/young person (if appropriate) and professional will discuss the findings and the outcome.
- A plan will be made with the child and parent/carer for next steps in supporting the family. This may include:
 - Signposting to sources of information and support
 - Advice to others involved
 - Attending training or groups for the parent/carer or child/young person
 - Individual support.
- The professionals involved will write a summary report to clarify the information from the assessments and to share recommendations with everyone involved.
- At the end of the episode of care the child/young person will be discharged.
