Dear Parent/Carer,

I'm writing to let you know that due to the current COVID-19 virus we need to make some changes to the level of care we provide as a service. We are very sorry that we are having to do this, but I'm sure you will understand that we need to reduce face-to-face contact as a way of reducing the spread of the virus, and we will also be working for a period of time with fewer staff as they may be self-isolating or on sick leave themselves.

These temporary changes might mean that your child is seen less frequently, offered telephone appointments rather than face-to-face appointments, or you might be contacted by people who are not yours or their regular workers. As a result, you might also find that your existing appointment has been cancelled (we will contact you separately if we do this).

We are very keen to support everybody who is receiving a service from us to the very best of our ability, and recognise what a stressful time this is. If you feel your child's needs change or if you have concerns related to your child's medical condition then please contact us on the above number to let us know (within usual office hours).

Please stay at home if you have coronavirus symptoms of either a high temperature (you feel hot to touch on your chest or back) or a new, continuous cough (this means you've started coughing repeatedly) or if someone in your household has these symptoms. Do not go to a GP surgery, pharmacy, hospital or any other NHS appointment. We would recommend that you follow the advice about COVID-19 which can be found at <u>www.nhs.uk/coronavirus</u>. We have also attached some useful websites about the Coronavirus and local numbers should you need family support.
