






# Apprenticeship opportunities

#### HR Support (Level 3, 18 months)

Working in either our Learning and Development or Recruitment Team, you will support a range of HR processes, from recruitment through to induction using HR systems to keep records; providing advice to managers on a wide range of HR issues. This apprenticeship will also lead to attainment of the Chartered Institute of Personnel (CIPD) Level 3 qualification. There may also be the opportunity to work across other HR teams.

#### **Business Administration (Level 3, 18 months)**

Working across our Trusts you will develop skills to coordinate meetings, undertake diary management, prepare high quality documents and work with a range of different software systems for efficient administration.
