"Anyone with a Learning Disability aged 14 or over, can get a free Learning Disability Annual Health Check at their Doctor's Surgery."

Doctor's Surgery	You go to your doctor's surgery for the Annual Health Check on the date and time of your appointment
	Annual Health Check is a head-to-toe health check
	Your doctor's surgery may ask to do part of your annual health check on the telephone or video call
	Your appointment needs to be at least 30 minutes long
	Your doctor's surgery may ask you to bring a sample of your wee
