



Derbyshire Perinatal Experts by Experience Meeting Agreement

The Perinatal Experts by Experience group meeting is an informal meeting where our **Experts by Experience** can come together to share experiences with the aim of shaping and developing future services.

- The meetings will be held online every 4-6 weeks with the option to have some meetings face to face if members wish.
- The meetings will be led by the Perinatal Clinical Lead and a Perinatal Peer Support Worker.
- Meetings will be scheduled for 1.5 hours to allow for sharing service developments, sharing ways you can be involved and time to connect with each other.
- All members of the group are welcome to share personal experience and expertise as much or as little as they wish to.
- The group will offer a confidential space and discussions should not be shared with others outside of the meetings.
- All members will be respectful and sensitive at all times.
- Please take breaks or attend to children throughout the meeting as needed.
- If anyone wishes to leave the meeting at any time they can do so. We would ask, if you do feel you need to leave; please contact the person leading the meeting - this is just so that we know that you are ok and can offer any additional support if required.
- If any member needs any additional support throughout the meeting or as a result of any involvement with the Expert by Experience group they should contact the Perinatal Clinical Lead.

An Expert by Experience is someone who has recent personal experience of using or caring for someone who has used Perinatal Mental Health Services.
